BACKGROUND

(Search) is a 501(c)(3) organization whose mission is to empower persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities to achieve their full potential, accept a valued role in their community, and lead rich, rewarding lives. For over 45 years, Search has provided high quality services and supports so that adults with disabilities can live, learn, work and play together in the community.



VISIBILITY ARTS

Visibility Arts is an immersive visual arts program of Search for people with intellectual disabilities. We provide group learning experiences and hands-on studio time where individuals get to apply what they learn. Visibility Arts is housed in a 7,000 square foot space in Mt. Prospect that includes fully equipped studio facilities and a spacious gallery for exhibitions. In addition, Visibility Arts programming is also offered at Search's Chicago and Waukegan locations. Individuals in the program meet and learn from other local artists and enjoy opportunities to show and sell their work in a variety of galleries and public venues throughout the year.
